- Be enrolled and in good standing as a full-time sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student at a North Dakota college or university in fall 2019.
- Be enrolled in arboriculture, urban/community forestry, horticulture, forestry, landscape architecture or other related fields as a major area of study.
